#### **Retrieving voicemail messages**

- Dial 625002 and press OK
- Enter default password 123456 followed by #
- Press 3 (you are now told how many messages you have)
- Press 3

Once you have listened to your message:

- Press 6 to delete
- Press 7 to replay
- Press 2 to skip to the next message
- Press 4 to save the message
- Press # to respond (then pressing 7 then 0 will ring the extension back)
- hang up if you are finished

### Setting up automatic call forwarding destinations

You may save the numbers you want to forward to as favourites. Then you can direct your calls straight to voicemail or another favourite number

- Press 🗗
- Press OK to choose edit call forwarding
- Choose destination and press OK
- Choose Edit favourites and press OK
- Choose Destination 1 and press OK
- Enter 625002 for voicemail or enter a colleagues number OK
- If you wish to set up another destination repeat the above for destinations 2 5
- Choose Options: Save & Exit and press OK
- Press <u>></u> to exit all menus

this sets up these numbers as your favourites for call forwarding

### Activating automatic call forwarding (the first time!)

- Press 🗗
- Press **OK** to choose edit call forwarding
- Choose **destination** and press **OK**
- Choose the destination you have set up previously and press OK
- Set All calls to on
- Choose Options: Save & Exit and press OK
- Press ≥ to exit all menus
